SMARTIES PLAYGROUP



WHO: Playgroup sessions are open to all children from birth to five years of age and their parents, carers or grandparents.

WHEN: Wednesday mornings
9:15 - 11:00 during school terms

WHERE: Kinder House on the hill.

WHAT: During this session children have the opportunity to join in fun learning experiences involving play such as painting, drawing, craft activities, puzzles, dressing up, building with blocks and construction kits, playing with musical instruments and lots more. There is also a quiet corner where parents/carers can sit and share books and stories with their children. Outside play is also encouraged in the fully enclosed yard around the Cottage - a sandpit with many buckets and spades, tricycles to ride on, balls to throw and catch, chalk drawing on the pavement, a balance beam and playground constructions to climb on and when the weather permits, a water play table - all this and more is designed to help children to develop their creative, social and motor skills.

SMARTIES GYM & STORYTIME



WHO: Gym sessions are open to all children from birth to five years of age and their parents, carers or grandparents.

WHEN: Friday mornings
9:20 - 11:00 during school terms

WHERE: Glen Huon Primary School Hall

WHAT: At the beginning of each session children will be encouraged to join in a singing and dancing warm-up before the start of the organised skill building session. Each week gym sessions will focus on a certain piece of equipment or a skill such as bean bags, balls, jumping, rolling, throwing and catching. All of these activities and the equipment used will assist children with their gross motor skills whilst playing and interacting with others. Parents are encouraged to participate with their children to assist them in learning these new skills.

At 10:00 we will stop for morning tea before sharing a story and doing a craft activity together. To finish the session the children will be encouraged to join in a song.

Please bring a piece of fruit or a healthy snack for your child.

Please note that the hall is open for free play activities from 9:00.

Pre-Kinder sessions will run in Term 4 for children starting school next year.

WHEN AND WHERE:

Our Borrow Bags are a significant part of the Friday morning Gym & Storytime session. Borrow Bags will also be on hand at Playgroup sessions on Wednesdays.

Borrow Bags can be returned to the front office at anytime.

WHAT: Inside each of our Borrow Bags will be a book along with resources including either a toy to play with or an activity based on the story that can be completed with your child. With your assistance, children can be encouraged to learn to enjoy books, derive great pleasure from the stories and activate their imaginations. Please be sure to keep the bag and contents intact when returning or exchanging the bag.
